Baylor camp faculty and staff will provide an opportunity for public school directors to expand knowledge and broaden understanding of information related to teaching public school instrumental music.

Daily Schedule

Participants will attend sessions and rehearsals during the day. During the afternoon, the camp faculty and staff will offer seminars and electives in the areas of instrumental pedagogy, conducting, and repertoire selection. Seminars will consist of lecture and group discussion topics related to teaching instruments and ensemble rehearsal.
